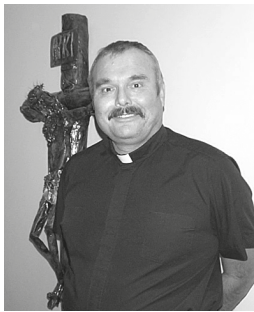


# FROM OUR PASTORAL STAFF

**Saturday Mass:** We have had numerous requests to keep the time of the Saturday Mass at 4:00 pm. This Mass will remain at 4:00 pm.

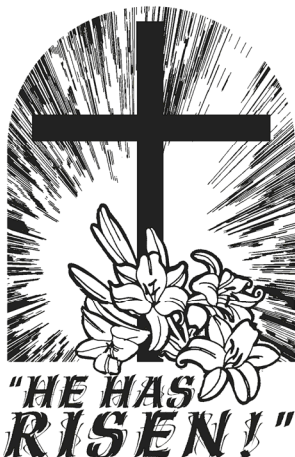

- \* **Main Entrance:** We ask that you enter the Church through the new main entrance doors. The remaining doors are to be used primarily for emergency exits.
- \* **Holy Water Font:** The Baptismal Font will now be our Holy Water Font as well. As you enter the church you are invited to bless yourself with the flowing water that circulates around the Font.
- \* **Confessions** will be held in the Reconciliation Room which is located next to the Choir Risers—south east corner.
- \* **Restrooms:** Access to the Women's restroom is next to the counter in the Gathering Space. The Men's restrooms will continue to be located either in the North West hallway near the Sacristy and in the hallway behind the Multi-purpose Room. Access is either through the hallway in the Gathering Area or through the double doors at the back of the Church.

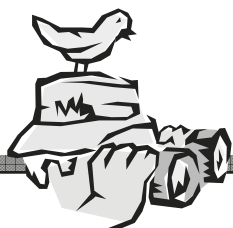
