FROM OUR LITURGY COMMISSION

The St. Felicitas Parish Liturgy Commission was created for the purpose of developing and implementing plans and action steps related to parish liturgical functions based on Diocesan guidelines for worship commissions, and the priorities and goals of the parish as determined by the Parish Staff and the St. Felicitas Parish Pastoral Council.

The Commission is and has been involved in fostering parish liturgical functions in a number of ways, such as the Children's Liturgy of the Word, the parish hymnals, parish concerts, the training of lectors and other lay ministers, overseeing changes in liturgical practices (e.g. bowing before receiving communion), and maintenance of liturgical objects (e.g. polishing the tabernacle). Additionally, the Commission is involved in planning and organizing the celebration of the Advent and Lenten seasons and the distribution of the "Little Books."

The Commission currently has eleven members, including Fr. Bober, Mary Muehle, Bill Schoeffler, Janel Berquist, Jane Vajda, Linda Fulton, Jim Miozzi, Jack Solpa, Stan Davisson (secretary), Jan Borkey (vice-chair), and William Knox (chair).

The word "liturgy" derives from the Greek meaning "public work," understood as service done in the name or on behalf of the people. The daily celebration of divine worship is the principal "public work" that we participate in as a church, as the people of God. The liturgy affects all of us. We view our role on the Liturgy Commission as one of service to the people of this parish. To this end, we encourage you, the parish, to contact us with your thoughts, comments, criticisms, whatever regarding the celebration of the liturgy at St. Felicitas. Messages can be left at the parish office.

- * **Handicap Seating:** There are several areas in the Church where the pews do not have a front rail and have staggered lengths. These areas are designed to accommodate wheel chairs at the end of the row. The pews without front rails will make seating easier for those who need walkers. There are several rows in the section in the main aisle just behind the offering table.
- * **Liturgical Ministers Seating:** The first row in the seating closest to the Cross is reserved for the Eucharistic Ministers and the Commentator.
- * **Handicap Parking:** There are several handicap parking spaces located to the right of the Main Drive. This area is between the Main Entrance and the Bell Tower. Follow the Main Drive past the main entrance and turn right. Signs are in place marking these spots.

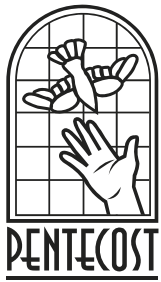
