They have many games and activities that go on. For two years we have worked there, helping with different activities. It was a lot of fun to do. My next favorite memory was when our Youth Group went to Kalahari’s indoor water park. There was so much to do there, like surfing, which Mr. Linsky did very well, water slides, and pools. My last favorite memory comes from the Relay for Life. The Relay for Life is a fundraiser for the American Cancer Society. Each team has to raise money. At the Relay you stay up for 24 hours and do many fun activities, volleyball games, scavenger hunts, and music is playing all day long and into the night. We have done this two years in a row and now into our a third year. The first year we collected \$1,500, the second year we stepped it up and did bake sales and collected around the neighborhoods, and raised \$5,000. This year we have really stepped it up, having more bake sales, a penny war, and a very successful garage sale. We have worked very hard to collect money for this great cause. Even though its been hard getting up really early to work garage sales, or walking to collect money it’s all worth it. I know this year will be really fun and our best yet. Youth Group to me is hanging out with friends and having fun. Thank you Mr. Linsky for the great memories.

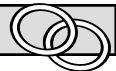
